

## BATON OF HOPE TOUR 2025

## North Lincolnshire - 15th September 2025

The Baton of Hope UK, a registered charity, was formed following a conversation between two dads Mike and Steve, who had both lost their sons to suicide. The Baton of Hope UK raises awareness of suicide prevention, improving access to information and services so as to prevent suicide. It acts as a national umbrella resource body to promote action, to improve understanding, services and responses; as a forum to bring about change and hope; and it is a catalyst for initiatives such as the work place charter, safe havens & mental health first aiders. North Lincolnshire has been selected as one of the 20 locations in the UK to be part of the Baton of Hope Tour which will takes place during 1st September- 10th October 2025. The date selected for North Lincolnshire is on Monday 15th September 2025.

There will be several stops planned throughout the day on the **15th** using significant landmarks across **North Lincolnshire** which may include: Baths Hall, Humber Bridge, such as our local Parks, Leisure Centres, Sports Venue, and prominent landmarks to maximise engagement and visibility.

The event is designed to raise the profile of suicide prevention by passing a Baton between people with lived experience of suicidal ideation or have been bereaved by suicide.

The Baton aims to change the stigma surrounding suicide, empowering those from all walks of life to identify and support those at risk.

The Baton also gives individuals the *confidence* and awareness needed to talk about suicide, whilst serving as a *tribute* to those who have lost their lives to *suicide*, whilst acknowledging the profound impact on those left behind.

The Baton of Hope stands for togetherness, solidarity, and *shared purpose*, advocating for open, *lifesaving* conversations that can drive meaningful change. Moreover, it calls for governmental action to address the underlying issues contributing to suicide and mental health challenges.

Our next steps for this event here at North Lincs will be:

- Engage with key stakeholders including local partners/Sportsclubs/ Schools, Local business sectors/ Voluntary Sector
- Identify venues/landmarks/community venues, that will host different programmes i.e talks, music, poetry /interaction at each of the location
- Identify key Public figures within NLC i.e Members of Parliament/ Elected Members /local sporting icon who can support/advocate the cause and local business Directors and including those with lived experience

The Baton of Hope, UK's biggest suicide prevention initiative, will pass through North Lincolnshire on 15th September, and you could get involved.

- Please note: Baton Bearers must be aged 16 or over. Those aged
   16 and 17 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
